## **DOCUMENTATION QUICK TIPS** The most helpful documentation for academic accommodation requests typically includes: • type of healthcare provider MEDICAL credentials/licenses PROFESSIONAL relationship to student (number of visits DETAILS or length of time as provider) evaluation method and testing results CONDITION diagnosis determined and severity level DETAILS impact/symptoms/restrictions experienced • specific medical needs (if applicable) current treatment or medication If you are unsure whether or not your documentation meets our standards, we recommend starting the process with what is readily available to you.

## **ACCOMMODATION ELIGIBILITY**

We holistically evaluate information received from the **student's selfreport**, **history**, and **medical documentation**.

If provided, accommodations used at a prior school and accommodations recommended by a medical professional will also be considered. However, <u>neither guarantee specific eligibility</u>.

Accommodation eligibility is determined through an **interactive process** following our office standards based on **ADA guidelines** and **best practices** in higher education.
