

COMPETENCY AT COMPLETION: ADVANCED PROGRAMS

Overview

Advanced candidates are recommended for program completion only after demonstrating proficiency across required CAEP Advanced Skills through multiple measures. Student Learning and Licensure (SLL) is used to generate competency and standards aligned reports by filtering rubric rows tagged to each CAEP Advanced Skill/ NELP standard. These reports are used for trend monitoring; however, completion approval is determined at the individual candidate level through verification of requirements.

Completion Cohort Context

Advanced candidates progress through programs using flexible pacing models. Because candidates enroll part-time and may complete internships, certification requirements, or portfolio components at different times, completion year data reflect the year of degree conferral rather than admission cohort. Monitoring occurs continuously throughout the program, and final recommendation for graduation and certification (if applicable) is based on documented verification of required assessments and proficiency thresholds.
